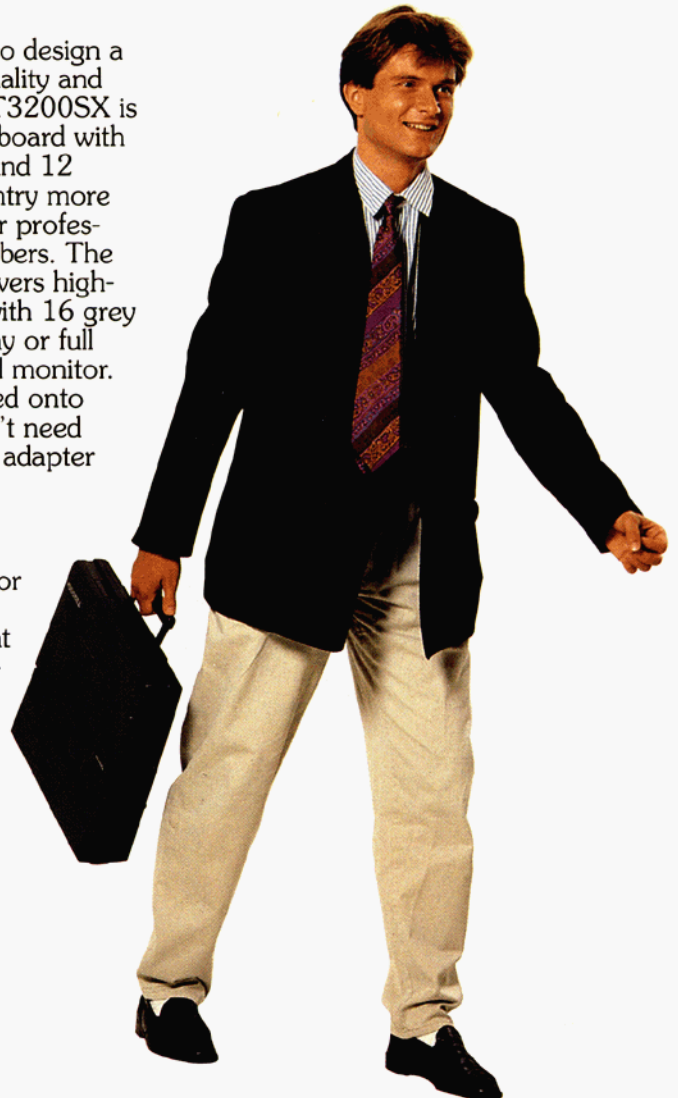

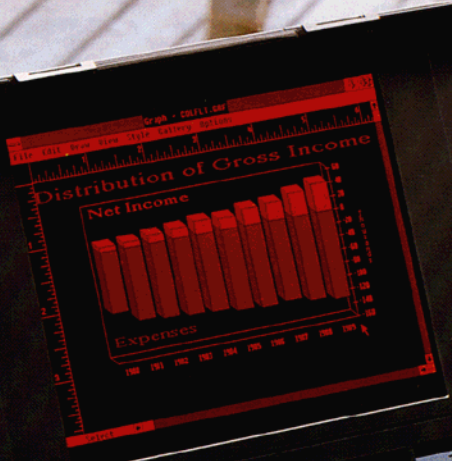

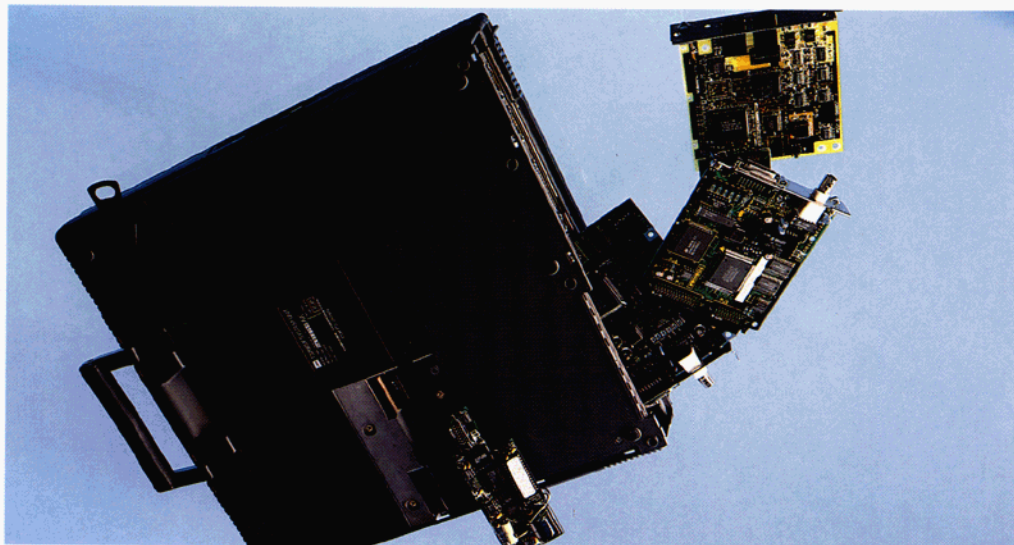

The T3200SX will speed through advanced applications at 16 MHz, and if you need even faster performance, you can add an optional Intel 80387SX™.

## 1-13 MB RAM

---

You can custom configure the T3200SX to your memory needs. The T3200SX comes standard with 1 MB of fast Toshiba RAM. But if you need more, you can add up to 13 MB RAM without using an expansion slot. Added memory is important if you choose to use OS/2™ or UNIX™. And since the T3200SX supports LIM EMS 4.0 and XMS 2.0, you can also take advantage of expanded and extended memory with the wide range of MS-DOS™ applications which use these standards. 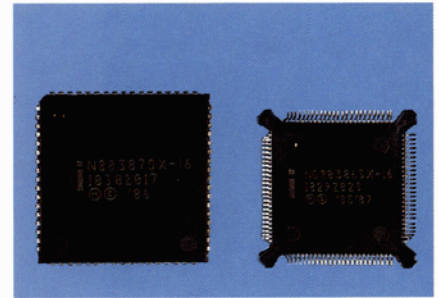
